

LEARN SCANDI CASTING

Headhunters will be offering our popular two-handed casting clinics again this winter. Our 1 day clinics begin Dec. 7th, 2013, The clinic is free, but class size is capped at 24 and <u>you must sign up beforehand</u> on a first icome first served basis.

FOCUS

Our clinics focus on basic two-handed casts and Scandi underhand techniques. Our casting and fishing instruction centers on the pursuit of Trout and Steelhead with floating lines and 6/7 weight two-handed rods. Skagit techniques and equipment will be covered as well.

INSTRUCTORS

Headhunters co-owner John Arnold has 25 years of twohanded fishing experience. He likes to keep it simple, focusing on "fishing" with a two-handed rod, not just "casting" with it. John is assisted by members of the Headhunters staff, as well as members of the fly fishing industry.

EQUIPMENT PROVIDED

If you have your own gear, bring it. It is always best to learn how to cast with the equipment you will be using. If you don't own any two-handed gear, Headhunters provides equipment from Sage, Orvis, Thomas&Thomas, Echo, RIO and Airflo for use and demo. This is a great opportunity to try some new rods and lines.

CLASSES

Begin with a morning classroom session that explains the differences between the various two-handed terms, techniques and equipment. This has been one of the most popular aspects of our class, and includes lots of Q&A.

After a short lunch break, we will head out to the river for on the water instruction. Wind direction often dictates the casts we work on, so every clinic is a bit different. Our goal is for you to leave with the skills to go out and try it on your own.

More advanced casters can also attgend to fine tune their skills and work on new casts. Student to instructor ratio is typically 4:1.

You will need... a valid Montana fishing/conservation license, waders and warm weather gear.
